

SELF DRIVING GUESTS

Please note:

- Original vehicle registration papers, a certified copy thereof, or letter from your bank is required for customs clearance prior to taking the vehicle across the border.
- You must at all times have a valid passport and driver's license.
- If the driver is not the registered owner of the vehicle, the rental company must give a letter of authorization to the driver to use the vehicle in Mozambique.
- 3rd party insurance is mandatory in Mozambique. This can be purchased at the Kosi Bay border post.
- A 4x4 vehicle is required to travel from the Kosi Bay Border post to White Pearl Resorts, Ponta Mamoli.

VISAS

Please contact your closest Mozambican Embassy for information on if you require a visa to enter Mozambique and if you can obtain this visa on entry or need to apply for it prior to travelling.

Visas cost approximately 80US\$ per person, but are subject to change according to government regulations.

Please take note that you need to carry cash on you should you wish to obtain and pay for a visa on arrival.

Border visas will only be issued to people travelling for purposes of tourism. It is essential that guests have on hand proof that they are tourists with proof of accommodation and departure ticket. The Resort will provide guests with proof of accommodation for this purpose.

Mozambican Meticaís, South African Rands, US Dollars and Euro´s are generally accepted.

SCUBA DIVING

Please note:

- Should there be children diving in your group we have a limited selection of sizes available.
- Strictly no diving without proof of certification
- If you are interested in completing a diving course, please contact us for the required diving medical form which needs to be completed by your local diving physician, prior to travelling to the resort.
- Horse riding has a weight restriction of 80kg per person.
- All boat based excursions are subject to being in a state of good health. Further details can be discussed with our activities manager.

DRESS CODE

Day time activities & meals require casual wear, evening meals and activities require semi-formal wear, no shorts, bare feet and beach wear will be permitted in the dining areas.

CHECK IN AND OUT TIMES

- Check in time is from 14h00 onwards
- Check out time is at 10h00
- Please take note that requests for late check outs and early arrivals can only be confirmed a day prior to arrival or departure
- Guest luggage storage facilities are available for any guests arriving early or departing later. Public areas can be used outside of the above times.
